**Objective: Promote the education of Beekeeping; promote our Association.**

- Partner with the Cabarrus County Extension Service
  - Extension Svc will distributed applications forms to schools with FFA curriculum
  - We will distribute application forms internally of our association members
  - FFA curriculum schools: Mt. Pleasant, NW, Central
- Gain recognition for our club:
  - picture in local papers (Independent Tribune)
  - award during Cabarrus County Fair "schools day" presentation
- **Requirements:**
  - Attend a minimum of three (3) Cabarrus County Beekeepers association meetings prior to application due date of May 1, 2010.
  - Experience a minimum of three (3) trips to a bee-yard with association member prior to application due date of May 1, 2010.
  - Complete application form by May 1, 2010
  - Provide an Essay on Beekeeping (specific topic is elective by applicant)
  - Scholarship money is to be used for higher education purposes only (student honor system / answer question on application form)
